JOB SUMMARY

As a leader of Markham Missionary Church, the Pastor is responsible to develop a spiritual environment where God's people have an opportunity to grow in their relationship with Jesus Christ and become salt and light in their community.

ORGANIZATIONAL RELATIONSHIP

According to MMC By-laws (Article II:1), the Lead Pastor is responsible to the Elders Council and is a member of it.

QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. The Lead Pastor shall be a man called by God to ministry.
- 2. The Lead Pastor shall be in agreement with the constitution of the Evangelical Missionary Church of Canada, the Markham Missionary Church Constitution and Bylaws, and minister within their guidelines.
- 3. The Lead Pastor shall be approved by the Credentialing Interview Team of the Evangelical Missionary Church of Canada.

DUTIES

- 1. Preach and teach God's Word.
- 2. Plan and organize all worship services.
- 3. Co-ordinate individual or group counseling as needed.
- 4. Oversee and participate in an effective visitation program which includes the sick, shut-ins, etc of our family, as well as the follow up of new contacts of the church.
- 5. Provide spiritual leadership for the church through vision casting, strategic planning and goal setting, including reaching the community for Christ.
- 6. Provide pastoral oversight in all church ministries and their functions.
- 7. Ensure the effective flow of communication among staff and congregation.
- 8. Ensure the proper functioning of staff responsibilities.
- 9. Perform additional duties as prescribed by the Elders Council.
- 10. Serve as ex-officio member of all boards and committees.
